<b>Motivation to Explore</b>	Religious and social rivalries between England and other European nations. Empire building. Northwest Passage.
<b>Leadership</b>	King Henry VII, King Henry VIII, Elizabeth I, King James I, King George
<b>Who were the explorers and where did they go?</b>	Henry Cabot - Newfoundland; Sir Walter Raleigh - Roanoke (John White); <b>Virginia Company - Jamestown - 1607</b>
<b>Settlements (if any?)</b>	<b>Raleigh - Roanoke - failed twice. JAMESTOWN 1607 - VIRGINIA COMPANY</b>
<b>Life in the Settlements</b>	Starvation, few settlers wanted to come, few women - see Jamestown notes
<b>What happened at the settlements? (Were they successful? Why or Why Not?)</b>	Roanoke - no - disappeared off the map with no explanation. Jamestown - yes, eventually, but life was very hard - see Jamestown notes
<b>Results &amp; Ramifications of Colonization</b>	13 Colonies, American Revolution, United States of America, birth of representative government and democracy
